CERTIFICATES OF COMPLIANCE – A REMINDER

We sent a circular letter to those approved companies that are still purchasing Paper Certificates of Compliance from NSI. If you did not receive the letter you can find it on the NSI website within the 'Circular Letters' section of the Company Login along with the attached FAQ's.

As a user of Paper Certificates, this letter explains how these will be discontinued in the near future, and to help you plan for this.

Currently Certificates of Compliance can be purchased from NSI in three different formats; eDirect, Electronic Blocks and Paper Triplicate Set pads.

About 85% of all certificates are now ordered as eDirect and Electronic Blocks, saving approved companies' time and helping improve accuracy in the issuing of certificates to customers.

Paper pads will continue to be available for purchase until **Wednesday 30th November 2016**, and paper certificate returns will only be accepted by NSI with an issue date up to **31st March 2017**.

From December 2016 Certificates of Compliance will only be available for purchase as:

- eDirect - providing a quick and easy way to buy and complete certificates on-line. Access the service via the secure Company Login area, where you can buy them individually or in multiples
- Electronic Blocks (supplemented by pre-printed certificate paper). These are available to approved companies using installer software packages.
