CHANGES TO FIRE BRIGADE CODES ON NSI/BAFE CERTIFICATES OF COMPLIANCE

I am writing to inform you that we have reissued our Fire Brigade Codes to be used when issuing NSI/BAFE Certificates of Compliance.

As many of you may be aware the fire and rescue services in Scotland are being integrated into one authority Scottish Fire and Rescue Service on 1 April 2013.

Due to the above change a new fire code for **Scottish Fire and Rescue Service (6300)** has been created and from 1 April 2013 onwards you should use this code on all NSI/BAFE Certificates of Compliance for relevant Scottish fire work. You should not use codes 5200 to 5900 for any work completed after 31 March 2013.

We have re-issued our list of Fire Brigade Codes to reflect this change as well as name changes that have already taken place to other fire and rescue services. In particular, I should like to point out that 3700, Somerset Fire Brigade is no longer on the list, due to the merger with Devon some time ago to form Devon and Somerset Fire & Rescue (1100). A copy is enclosed and you will find a copy on our website.

Would you please ensure that you pass this information to the person(s) in your organisation responsible for issuing NSI/BAFE Certificates of Compliance.
