1: IMPLEMENTATION OF NSI CODE OF PRACTICE NCP 104 ISSUE 3

2: IMPLEMENTATION OF PD 6662:2017

1: NCP 104 Issue 3 (Refer to Circular Letter NSI 025/17 and Technical Bulletin TB 0041)

This is a reminder that Issue 3 of NCP 104 for the design, installation and maintenance of CCTV surveillance systems supersedes issue 2 of NCP 104 on 30th April 2019 and all new contracts entered into from **1st May 2019** will need to comply with the requirements of NCP 104 Issue 3.

Your documentation will need to indicate the issue of NCP 104 the system is installed to.

2: PD 6662:2017 (Refer to Circular Letter NSI 023/17 and Technical Bulletin TB 0040)

This is also a reminder that the PD 6662:2017 Scheme for the application of European standards for intrusion and hold-up alarm systems supersedes PD 6662:2010 on 31st May 2019 and all new contracts entered into from **1st June 2019** will need to comply with the requirements of PD 6662:2017.

Your documentation will need to indicate the version of PD 6662 the system is installed to.

In preparation for these introductions, if you are able to comply with the new requirements earlier, you can install to the new requirements prior to the above dates.
