**UPDATE OF DOCUMENT NSF 670 (MARKING TABLE FOR PD 6662:2017 AND BS 8243)**

BS 8243 Clause 5.4.3 (Configurations of movement detectors with no overlapping area of coverage) requires you to declare to the response authority, e.g. The Police, where you have used two movement detectors of the same technology in a single housing to generate a confirmed alarm. The most recent release of the NPCC security systems policy removes the need to declare the use of this type of detector.

Due to this discrepancy, the NSI have now removed this requirement from our audit checklist, and document NSF 670 (PD 6662:2017 marking table) has undergone an update to indicate deviation A6 (BS 8243: 5.4.3) as 'No longer applicable'.

**The update to document NSF 670 may require your internal audit documentation and processes to be amended in line with this change.**


