INTRODUCTION OF NEW NSI CODE OF PRACTICE NCP 119 FOR THE PROVISION OF LABOUR IN THE SECURITY AND EVENTS SECTOR

Earlier this year, NSI circulated the draft of a new Code of Practice for the provision of labour in the security and events sector (NCP 119). NSI has developed this code due to feedback from industry and evidence of poor practices that threaten the credibility of our industry.

This new code enhances confidence in the supply chain for your buyers by ensuring, through audit of labour providers, that areas such as screening, training, right to work, payment of minimum wage and working time regulations are adhered to for all personnel supplied.

I am pleased to inform you that NSI will begin offering approval to the code of practice as of 1st April this year.

As a new mandatory requirement, NSI Gold and Silver approved companies are required to ensure that, by 31st March 2021, all labour providers used within their supply chain are approved to the code.

The code, whilst in development, has received a great deal of support from Approved Companies and we thank everyone who commented, contributed and raised awareness of its arrival.

NSI's mission is to help raise standards in industry and we are confident that, with your support, this new code of practice will have a positive effect on the industry in both safeguarding your supply chain and protecting your brand reputation.
