BSI REQUEST FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON GUARDING STANDARD
BS 8406 - EVENT STEWARDING - CODE OF PRACTICE

BSI are revising the BS 8406 standard for event stewarding, and the revision process has now reached the public comment stage. The changes reflect the way security providers want to use British Standards.

BS 8406 details the ways in which an organisation manages the service provision of event stewarding. It is intended to be applied in conjunction with BS 10800.

Although this British Standard is aimed at organisations that provide event stewarding services on a contracted basis, its provisions and guidelines could be equally applicable to those companies operating an in-house service provision.

These Code of Practices were drafted by industry through the constitution of the BSI GW/3.

Your opportunity to comment!

BSI are inviting comment on this draft, for the committee to then review and resolve. The public comment period ends on the 11th of June 2020.
