IMPORTANT: REQUIREMENT FOR ARCs REGISTERING FOR ECHO TO HOLD CYBER ESSENTIALS CERTIFICATION

There is a requirement for all Alarm Receiving Centres (ARCs) registering for ECHO to hold either Cyber Essentials (basic) or Cyber Essentials Plus certification.

ARCs can start the ECHO registration process without certification and can progress through to completion of configuration and testing but will need to supply their Cyber Essentials certificate at the contract signing stage to enable them to go live on ECHO and be connected to the Police.
